## Life in Australia - Australian values

The Australian Government encourages people to gain an understanding of Australia, its people and their way of life, before applying for a visa to live in Australia.

This includes acknowledging what would be required if they later applied for Australian citizenship.
Members of the family unit who are seeking to be added to an existing application, which was lodged before 15 October 2007, may not need to sign the statement. If the member of the family unit has concerns about signing the statement then they, or the main visa applicant, should speak to their case officer.

In your visa application you will be asked for information about each member of your family unit (such as your partner or children) even if they do not intend to migrate with you. Information about which family members are considered to be a 'member of your family unit' for migration purposes is available by referring to form 1496i Including family members in your application. Form 1496i is available from the Department's website www.homeaffairs.gov.au/about/corporate/information/forms or offices of the Department. You should ensure that you read and understand form 1496i before completing this form.
