This form must be completed for each member of the family unit aged 18 years or over **whether migrating or not**. If there is insufficient space to answer, provide details under 'Additional information' at the end of this form.

## Life in Australia - Australian values

The Australian Government encourages people to gain an understanding of Australia, its people and their way of life, before applying for a visa to live in Australia.

This includes understanding that the English language, as the national language, is an important unifying element of Australian society. Australian society is also united through the following shared values:

- respect for the freedom and dignity of the individual;
- freedom of religion;
- commitment to the rule of law;
- Parliamentary democracy;
- equality of men and women;
- a spirit of egalitarianism that embraces mutual respect, tolerance, fair play and compassion for those in need and pursuit of the public good;
- equality of opportunity for individuals, regardless of their race, religion or ethnic background.

The Life in Australia booklet provides more information on the values that Australians share and their way of life. This booklet is available in a wide range of languages. If the member of the family unit has not already received a copy of the booklet then it can be obtained from www.homeaffairs.gov.au

If the member of the family unit is applying for a visa to migrate to Australia then they must have read the Life in Australia booklet before completing this application form. If they have difficulty, or are unable to read the booklet, they may have the content of it explained to them, for example, by a friend or relative. This form contains a statement, that they must sign, that confirms they understand and will respect the values of Australian society (as explained in the booklet) and will obey the laws of Australia. This includes acknowledging what would be required if they later applied for Australian citizenship.

Members of the family unit who are seeking to be added to an existing application, which was lodged before 15 October 2007, may not need to sign the statement. If the member of the family unit has concerns about signing the statement then they, or the main visa applicant, should speak to their case officer.

#### Including family members in your application

In your visa application you will be asked for information about each member of your family unit (such as your partner or children) even if they do not intend to migrate with you. Information about which family members are considered to be a 'member of your family unit' for migration purposes is available by referring to form 1496i Including family members in your application. Form 1496i is available from the Department's website www.homeaffairs.gov.au/about/corporate/information/forms or offices of the Department. You should ensure that you read and understand form 1496i before completing this form.

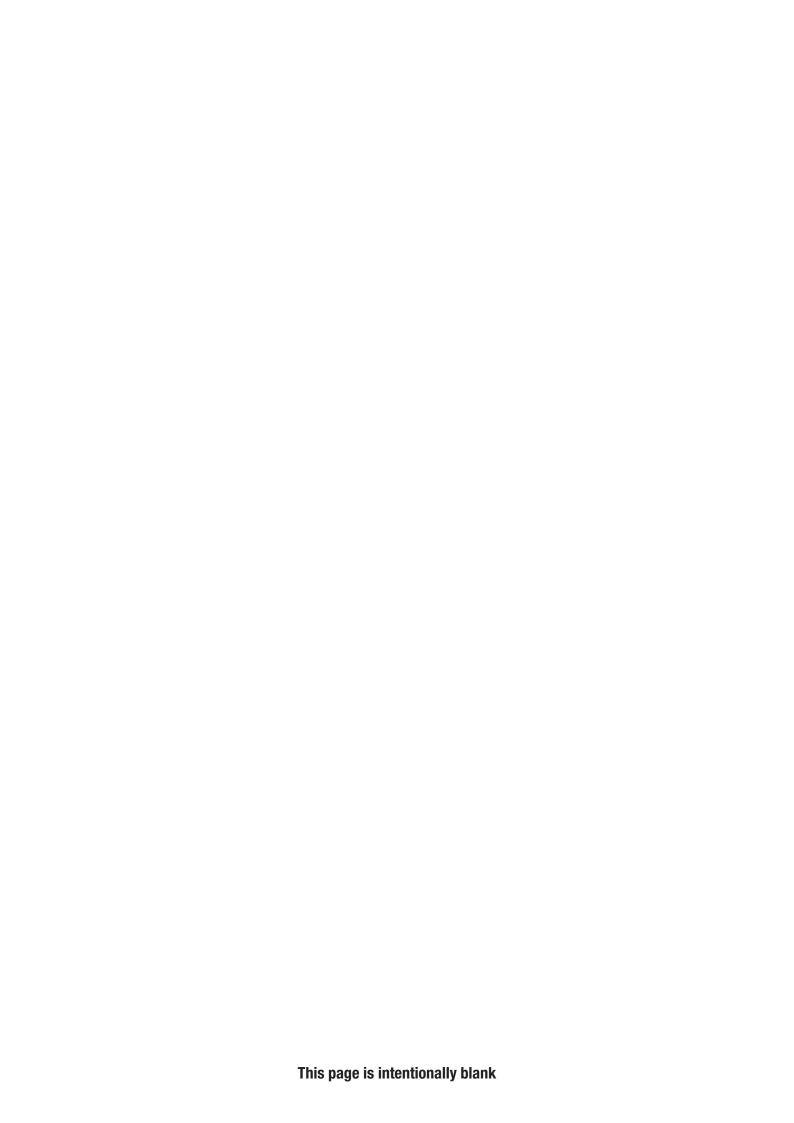
